

Installation Quick Start Guide for WSG-7

Important Installation Instructions

- 1. Turn off the water supply to your system.
- Turn on faucet to drain the tank. This process may take a several minutes. It is recommended to reuse this water around your home to water your plants or garden.
- Remove the prefilter and postfilter by rotating them to the left 1/3 of a turn. Note: System should be sanitized when replacing the prefilter and postfilter. Refer to your system Owner's Manual for specific instructions.
- Remove sanitary cap from new filter. Insert new filters into the manifold by turning to the right about 1/3 turn until the filter stops. The filters will rise up as they are turned. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
- Turn your water supply on to fill the system. This may take a few hours. Inspect the system for leaks.
- To reset your timer, please refer to your system owner's manual for specific instructions.
- 7. Turn faucet onto flush and empty the filled storage tank once.

REPLACE FILTER EVERY 6 MONTHS, OR IF BAD TASTE OR 0000 OCCUR.

Installation shall comply with applicable state and local regulations. The risk associated with small parts can cause choking if swallowed. Keep children away from small parts during the replacement of the water filter.
